- 10. Highways and road safety issues:** Adam Mayo (Highways Engineer, NCC) has suggested that a full survey of traffic and safety on Golf Links Road and Chapel Road is needed, at a cost of around £6k. CM is seeking funding via County Councillor Dewsbury and will contact Wymondham College for possible assistance. Adam Mayo has logged this as a feasibility site. A new “road narrows” sign has appeared on Golf Links Road.
- 11. Flooding on Permissive Path:** Anglian Water have been seen working on and near the site.
- 12. Playground:** await quote from BC for resurfacing the Turner Field carpark.
- 13. Water Meter/Leak:** NCC Highways blocked Anglian Water from road closures until school holidays. The temporary fix has worked well so far and it is now possible to assess the water loss to make a claim.
